**Schedules:**

- Practices will be 1-2 times per week
- Games will be 1-2 times per week as well
- Expect between 18-22 total events for the season
- Tryouts 10/28 and 10/30
- We release a 2-week Preliminary schedule on Friday 11/1 after tryouts
- Team placement Friday 11/1
- Game Schedule released by ADAL week of 11/11
- Full Season Schedule (Practice & Games) released 9/15
- Events are generally Monday - Thursday and 3-8pm (some exceptions apply)
- We do our best to balance available gym/field space among all 15-20 SCSD teams

**ADAL League:**

- League ranges as far north as Half Moon Bay/San Mateo and as far South as Palo Alto
  - Traditionally, each team will play 10 games before the start of playoffs(which will be determined by placement in the league)

**Registration:**

Registration can be found on our website [www.scsdsports.org](http://www.scsdsports.org) under the registration tab

- Registration must be completed before they attend any events (games)
- Students cannot be placed on a team unless they are registered
  - The last day to register to be placed on an A team is August 28th
  - If not registered by the 28th then they will be placed on a B team
  - Final day to register regardless of team is August 30th
- A \$75 dollar deposit fee will be kept if any participant leaves the team after the schedule has been released.

**Playing Time:**

- B team playing time will be split evenly among all players who participate
- Everyone should play in all A team games, however, playing time will not be even and those who are more committed and/or experienced in the sport will play more
- Playing time may be reduced, or removed entirely, for players who do not meet school, attitude, or commitment expectations including being late or missing practices or school.
- All Teams focus on player development through practices and game experiences

**Uniforms:**

- Uniforms will be distributed at one of the first practices
- If uniform is not returned, a \$50 dollar fee will be charged to the card that was used to purchase registration
